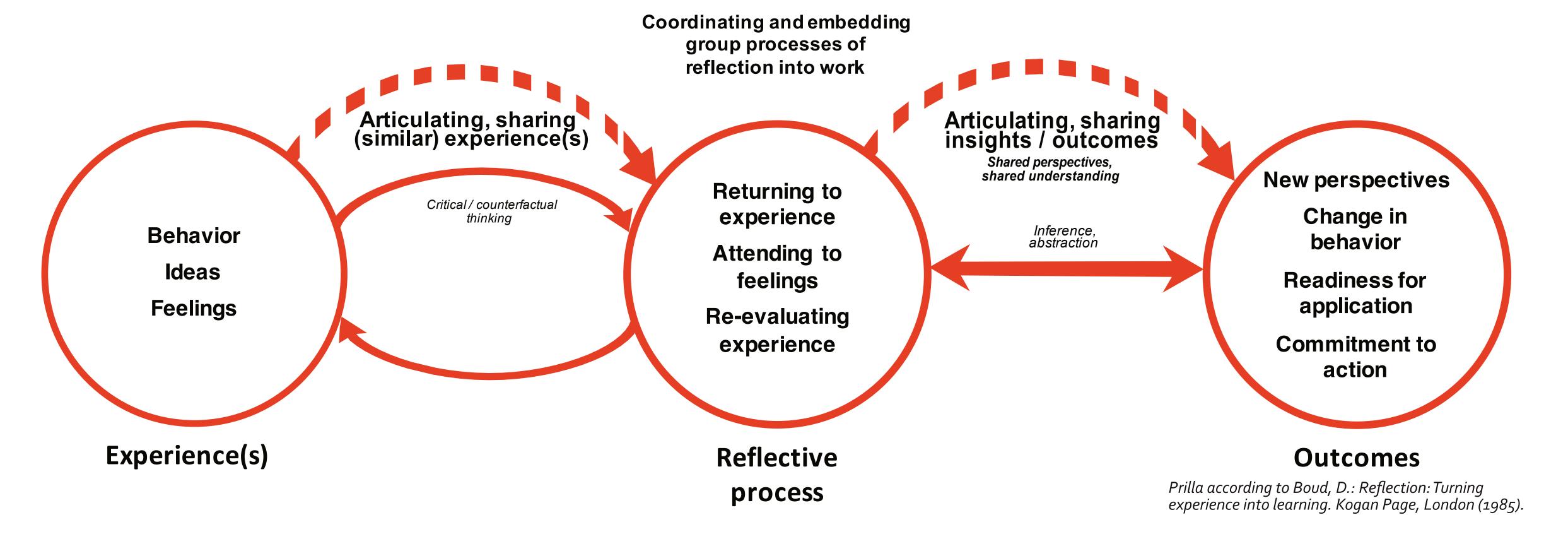

WHAT IS A COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE?

People in the same domain of work discuss their practice, exchange experiences and learn together.

The EmployID Community Platform offers:

- A unique way to form networks
- Learn from each other
- Without the need to meet in person
- Independent from personal schedules
- Improve horizontal & vertical communication

REFLECTION IN A COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE:

- Support reflective learning directly by focusing on
 - ... sharing experiences
 - ... sharing solution proposals
- Providing content to reflect on (e.g., hot topics in organizations),
- Connect employees with similar tasks,
- Offering closed and public forums for experience exchange,
- Prompting people to engage in reflection

(e.g. asking for experience exchange).

"So ... when I check the platform I think what I have to say about it and then what can help me to do my job better, where can I do some improvements ..."

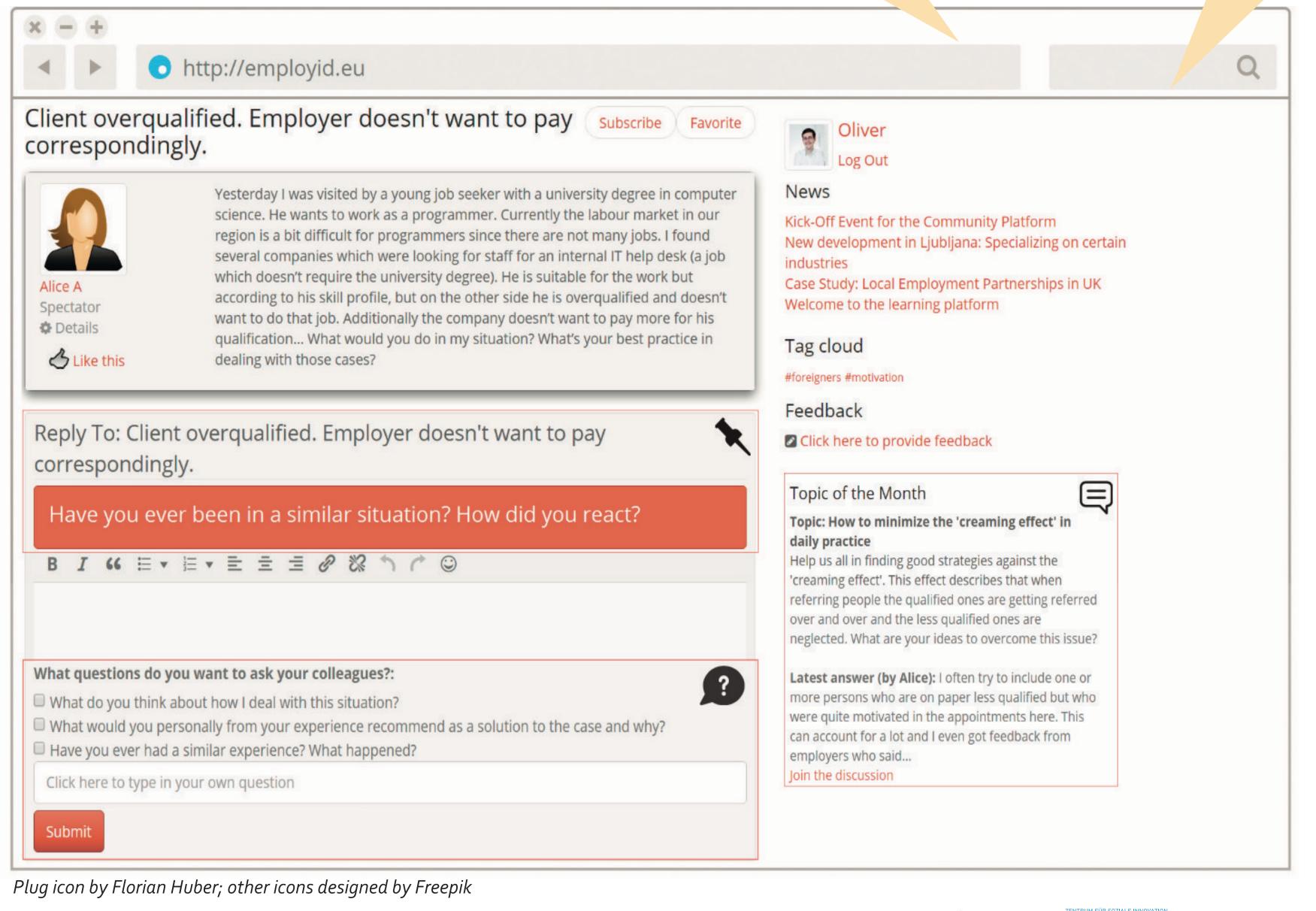

REFLECTION AS A PLUGIN

We build reflection features into existing tools

- 1. Enable long-term usage of a reflection tool by embedding features in existing communication tools (i.e. community tools, learning platforms)
- 2. Reflection tools are only helpful in specific contexts. Implement only the features needed for the learning context
- 3. Use existing tools to lower acceptance barriers of reflection features
